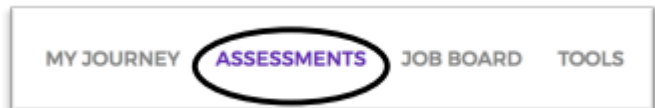




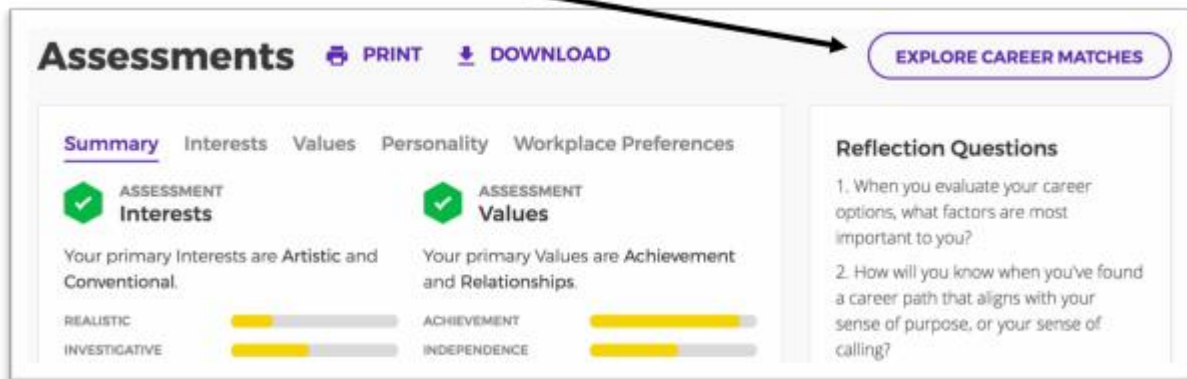
Career Match Exercise

- To begin exploring your career matches, go to jobzology.uncc.edu and login to your account

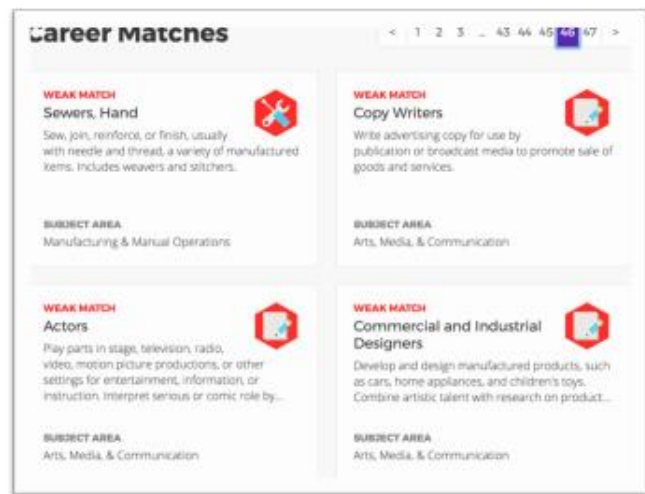
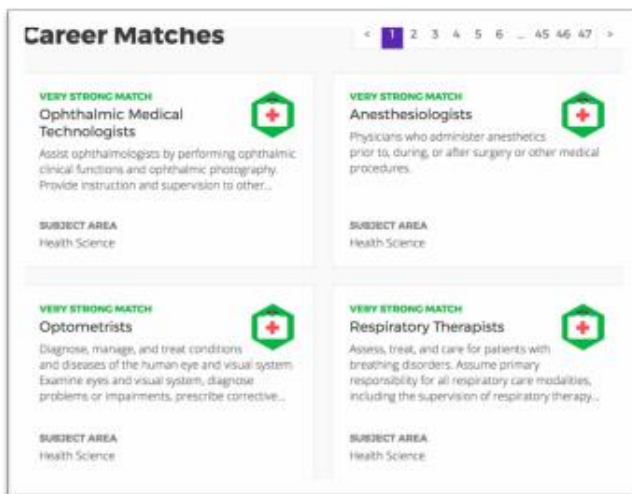


- Click on the **Assessments** tab to view your results.
